ARTT-223 Motion Graphics 3 Credits

Description

This course will include basic skills in motion graphics: color, form, typography, design and movement of design elements. Students will utilize software such as Adobe Photoshop and After Effects to create compositions. Prerequisite: ARTT-112. (4 hours weekly)

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

1. Import and manipulate multi-layered Photoshop compositions in After Effects.
2. Import Illustrator files and animate text.
3. Create timelines, keyframes, mattes and masks.
4. Demonstrate proficiency in transfer modes and advanced effects.

Major Topics

- I. Scanning images
- II. Creating compositions in Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator
- III. Creating motion graphics using After Effects

Course Requirements

Grading/exams: Grading procedures will be determined by the individual faculty member but will include two quizzes or exams and at least one creative lab activity.
