## **MUSC-112; 113** **Applied Music (Non-Music Major)** 2 Semester Hours; 1 Semester Hour

#### **Description**

Individual instruction for pre-college or personal enrichment. (MUSC-112 is an hour lesson each week; MUSC-113 is a half-hour lesson each week.)

#### **Overall Course Objectives**

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

1. Perform beginning repertoire in his/her respective instrument or voice.
2. Demonstrate a knowledge of music fundamentals such as note reading, rhythm reading, and key signatures.
3. Demonstrate a correct technical approach through scales, etudes, or other exercises.
