Description

First and second semesters of private college level music study. MUSC-117 and 118 are required for the music major. MUSC-119 and 120 are 1 half-hour lesson per week. MUSC-117 and 118 are 1 hour lesson per week.

Overall Course Objectives

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

1. Perform intermediate repertoire in his/her respective instrument or voice.
2. Perform a jury examination before his/her instructor and the music director in which he or she demonstrates the following: good intonation, phrasing, rhythm, stylistic understanding, tone, and overall musical sensitivity.
3. Demonstrate an intermediate level of technical proficiency in the performance of scales, etudes or other exercises.
