**\*\*Recommended Arts & Sciences Electives: EDUC 110, EDUC 200, EDUC 202, EDUC 260 or EDUC 270.**

Students in the Teacher Education Transfer Program are required to submit scores from Praxis I: Academic Skills Assessments to the Social Sciences Division prior to the completion of the 45<sup>th</sup> credit hour. The exam assesses basic reading, writing, and mathematics skills. Scores from Praxis I are used for admission to four-year Teacher Education programs and are required for Teacher Certification in Maryland and most other states. Students may take Praxis I in two different formats: Pre-professional Skills Test (PPST-paper and pencil format) or Computer-Based test (CBT-on a computer). Maryland passing scores for the PPST are currently 177 in Math, 177 in Reading, and 173 in Writing. Maryland passing scores for the CBT are 322 in Math, 325 in Reading, and 319 in Writing.
