+ A student applying to NURS 101 or NURS 111 must have placement into ENGL 121 or have completed required English developmental courses.

*** Admission to the Nursing Program is based upon successful completion of required courses. Prerequisite courses must be completed with grades of C or better. For Fall 2007, students must complete at least one of the prerequisite courses with a B or an A. For Fall 2008, students must complete at least one of the prerequisite SCIENCE courses with a B or an A. Nursing courses must also be completed with grades of C or better. Be aware that A&P I and A & P II must be no older than 5 years for students applying for Nursing beginning Fall 2003.**

Students in this program must meet with an advisor regularly and maintain current information regarding the policies of the institutions to which they intend to transfer.
