- A grade of "C" or better is required in all math, science and nursing courses.
- *Anatomy and Physiology courses must be completed within five (5) years of beginning the first nursing course. If course work exceeds the five year limit, a student may either take a competency exam(s) to demonstrate proficiency or repeat the course(s). BIOL-107 must be completed within ten (10) years of beginning the first nursing course.
- **Students planning to apply for entry into the A.A. Degree Nursing Program should consider taking MATH-121, 131 or higher in place of MATH-105, if eligible.
