- Admission to the *Accelerated* Nursing Program is competitive. Eligible candidates must demonstrate successful completion of all required General Education Core courses, with an overall minimum 3.0 GPA prior to applying.
- *CHEM-103, BIOL-107, BIOL-203 and BIOL-204 must be completed with a minimum 3.25 GPA and no grade lower than “C.”
- A grade of “C” or better is required in all math, science and nursing courses.
- Anatomy and Physiology courses must be completed within five (5) years of beginning the first nursing course. If course work exceeds the five year limit, a student may either take a competency exam(s) to demonstrate proficiency or repeat the course(s). BIOL-107 and CHEM-103 must be completed within ten (10) years of beginning the first nursing course.
- **If considering transferring to a four-year institution, check the requirements of the receiving institution.
