

ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY I AND II COMPETENCY EXAMS

- Anatomy and Physiology I and II cannot be over 5 years old by the time a student begins his/her first nursing course.
- If a student's Anatomy and Physiology I and/or II course is over 5 years old by the time the student begins his/her first nursing course at Howard Community College, he/she can take Competency Exams in Anatomy and Physiology I and/or II.
- If a student passes the Competency Exams, the Anatomy and Physiology courses will be transferred in. These A&P courses must have been completed with a grade of "C" or above.
- Students must submit a Request to Take Anatomy and Physiology Competency Exams form to the Office of Admissions and Advising (RCF-242) to request dates to take the exams.
- The Competency Exams are taken in the Test Center (RCF-359).
- Each test has 100 questions.
- There is no time limit when taking the exams.
- Students need a score of 65 to pass.
- Students can take each Competency Exam only one time.
- There is no cost to take the tests.
- Class materials for the lecture and lab components of Anatomy and Physiology I and II are on sale in the bookstore to help review for the tests.
- Students need to review more than the above materials to prepare for these Competency Exams. They should also be reviewing Anatomy and Physiology textbooks.
