

LPN PATHWAY SEQUENCE PROGRAM CHECKLIST

To be eligible for the LPN Pathway Sequence Program, which begins with NURS-103, you must hold an active unencumbered Maryland or compact LPN license. This license must remain active throughout the program.

In order to submit an LPN Pathway Sequence Supplemental Application, you must complete the following requirements:

- ___1. Complete and submit Howard Community College's Application for Admission to the Office of Admissions and Advising (RCF-242). A \$25 application fee is required. Declare LPN Pathway Sequence (code number 08c) as your learning program. Submission of an HCC Application for Admission does not guarantee admission into the LPN Pathway Sequence Program.
- ___2. Request official college transcripts from previous postsecondary institutions and submit an Official Transcript Evaluation Request Form to the Office of Admissions and Advising. You will be billed a \$15 Transcript Evaluation fee upon completion of the evaluation.
- ___3. Take HCC's English placement test. This is a requirement for ALL prospective nursing students, even those who have already completed college-level English courses at an institution other than HCC. Students who have earned a U.S. bachelor's degree from an accredited institution are exempt from taking the English placement test. The placement test may be taken twice. Scores are valid for two years.
- ___4. Place into ENGL-121 on HCC's English placement test or complete all required developmental English courses with grades of C or better. Students who place into developmental English courses and have transferred college English courses to HCC must see a nursing advisor to determine English course requirements.
- ___5. Complete MATH-122, MATH-138 or higher (MATH-141, College Algebra, or MATH-138, Statistics, is recommended).
- ___6. Complete BIOL-107 or BIOL-200 (Microbiology, 4 credits with lab) within 10 years of entrance to the LPN Pathway Sequence Program.
- ___7. Complete CHEM-101 or CHEM-103 (Chemistry, 4 credits with lab) within 10 years of entrance to the LPN Pathway Sequence Program.
- ___8. Complete BIOL-203 (Anatomy and Physiology I) and BIOL-204 (Anatomy and Physiology II), each 4 credits with lab, within 5 years of entrance to the LPN Pathway Sequence Program.
- ___9. Complete HMDV-200 (Life Span Development).
- ___10. Complete ENGL-121 (College Composition I).
- ___11. Complete PSYC-101 (General Psychology).
- ___12. Pass the HESI LPN-RN Mobility Exam.
- ___13. Complete and submit the LPN Pathway Sequence Supplemental Application with a \$25 application fee. You must have completed or be registered for your final prerequisite courses at the time that you submit the supplemental application. Submission of the supplemental application and completion of all prerequisites, testing and other requirements does NOT guarantee acceptance into the program.

Applicants must have an overall 2.0 GPA in prerequisite and co-requisite college courses to be eligible for NURS-103. All science, math, nursing, and required developmental (or college-level English) courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. An overall GPA of 2.0 in all HCC coursework is required.
