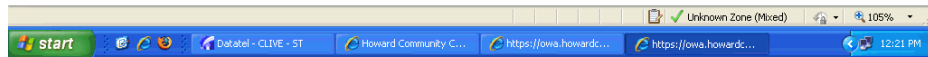
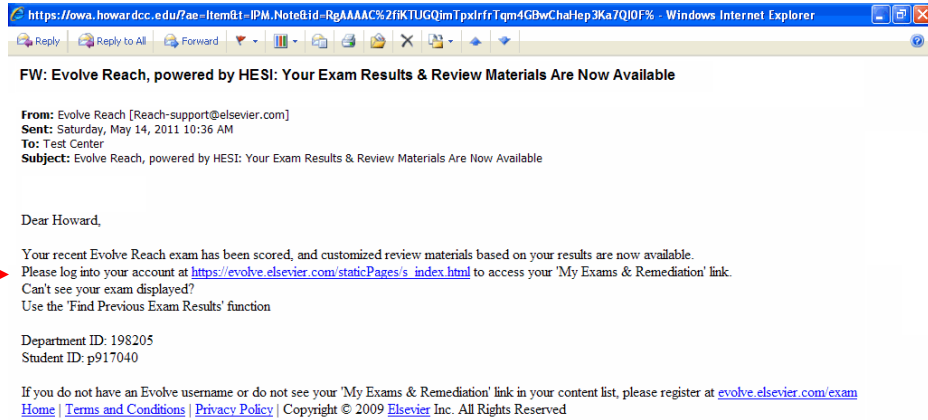


How to Access Your HESI/Evolve Testing Remediation Materials

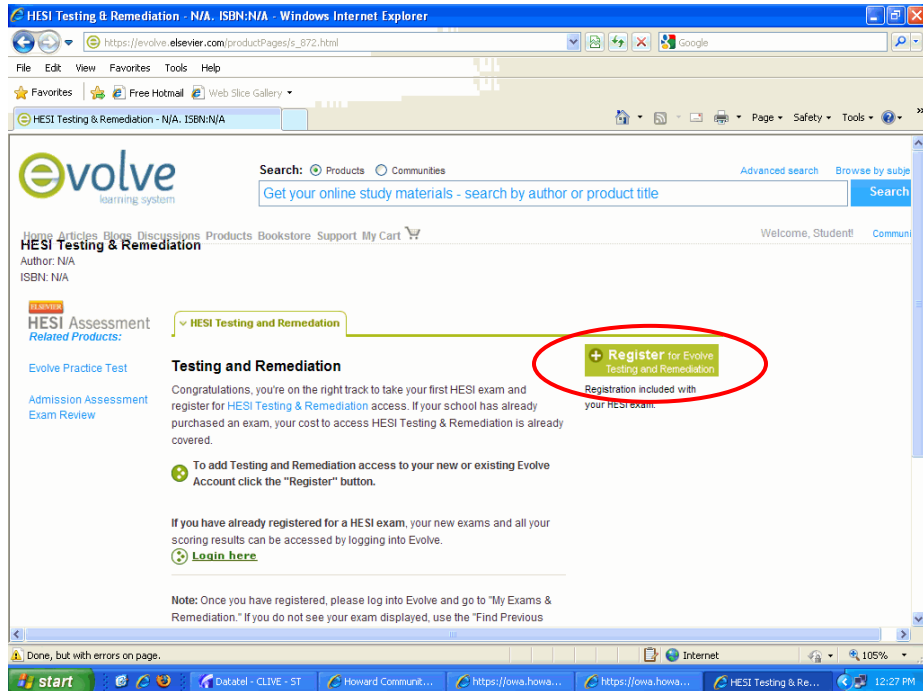


The purpose of this publication is to provide information to post-test candidates regarding accessing HESI/Evolve Remediation.

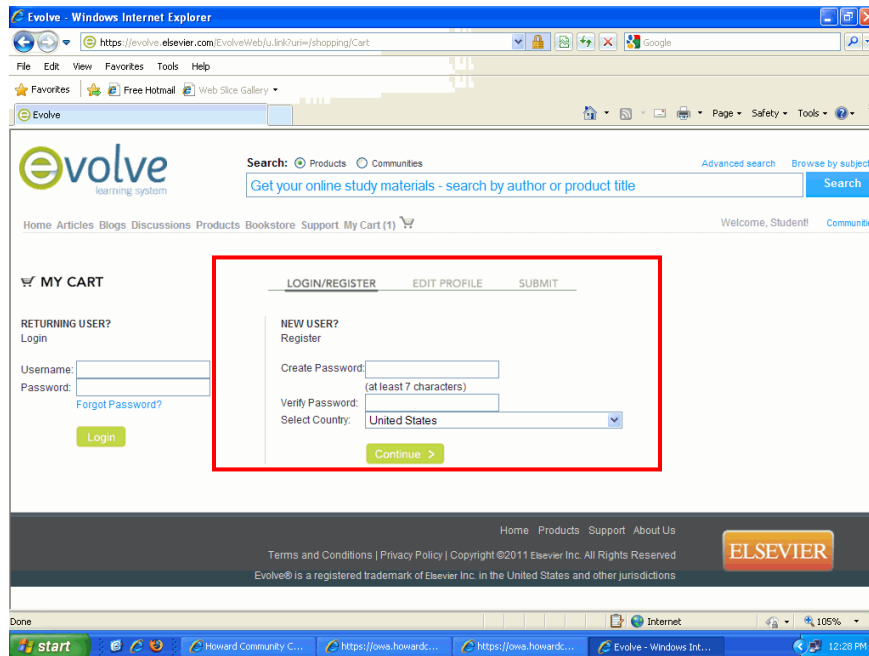
When you complete your Clinical Nursing Admission Assessment, you will receive an email from Elsevier that instructs you to complete your account profile. Click the link in the email to get started.



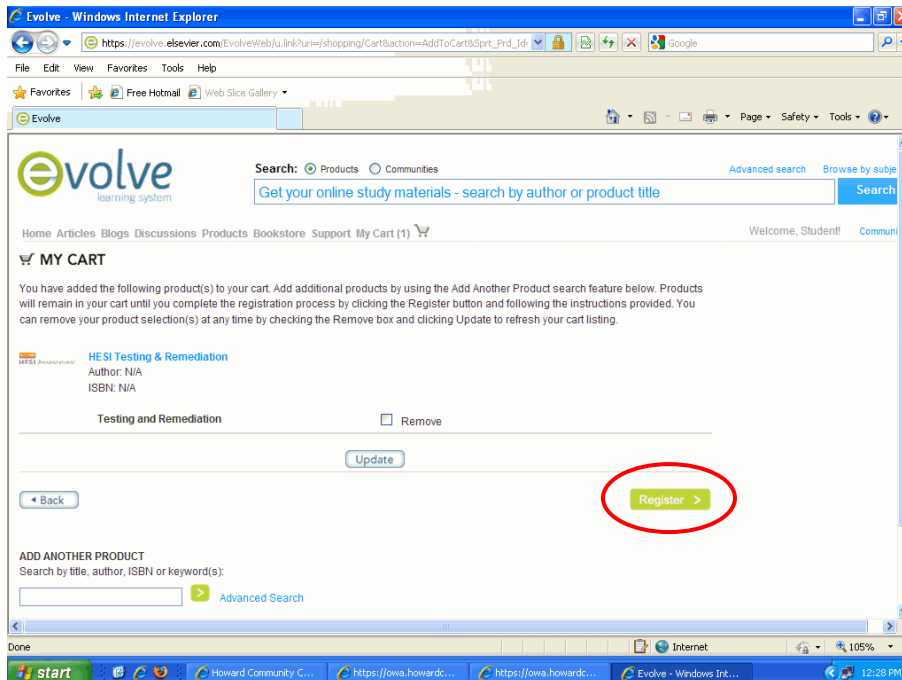
The link in the email will take you to the page below. Click the green Register box.



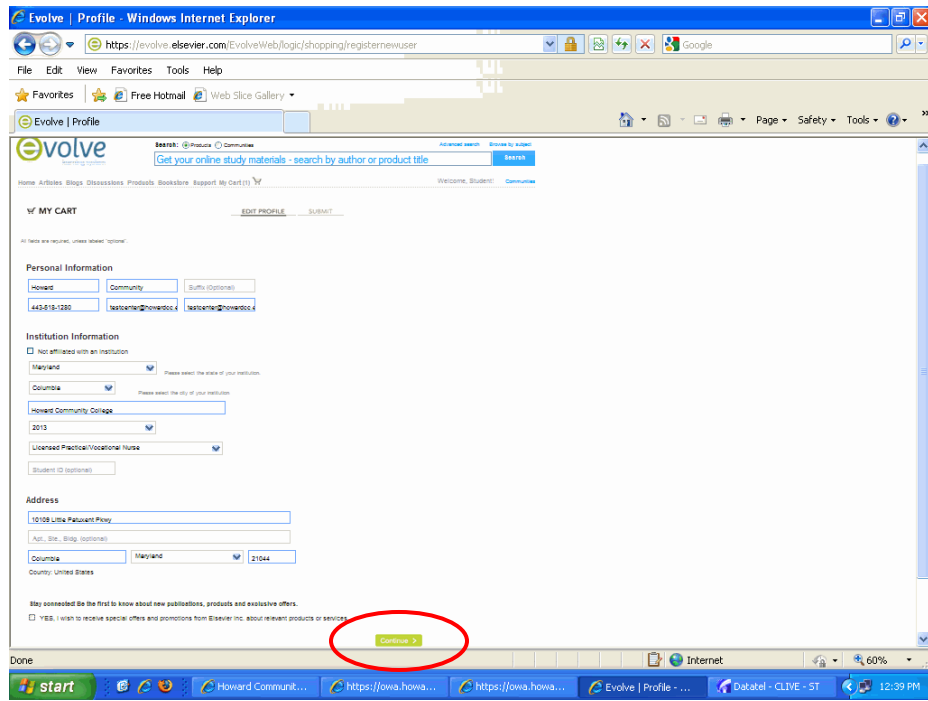
Type the password of your choice into each box. Click "Continue"



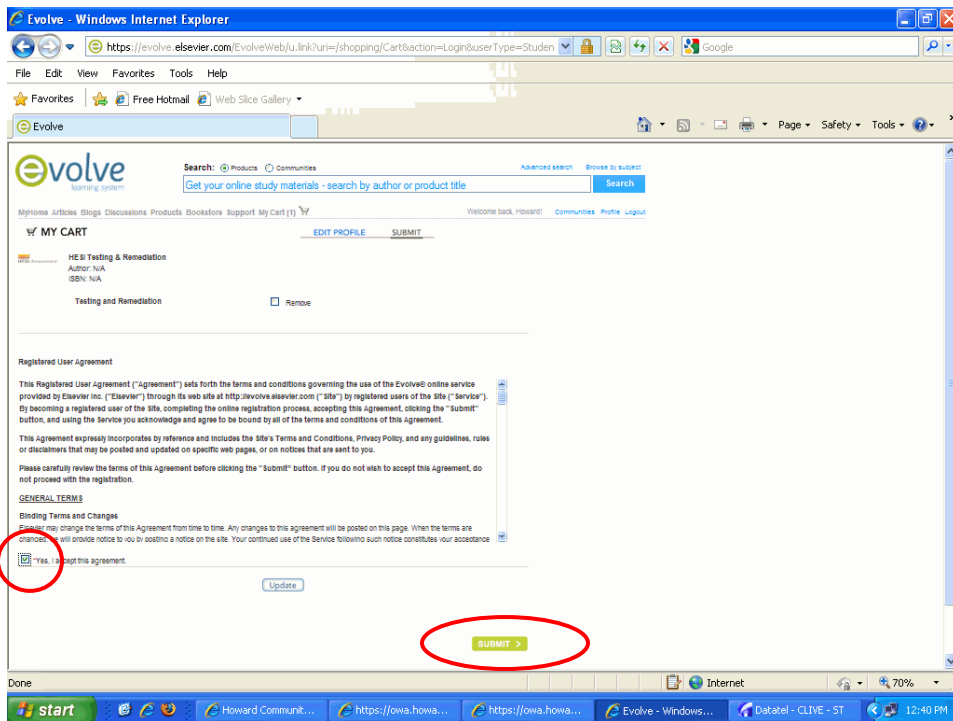
Click the green "Register" button.



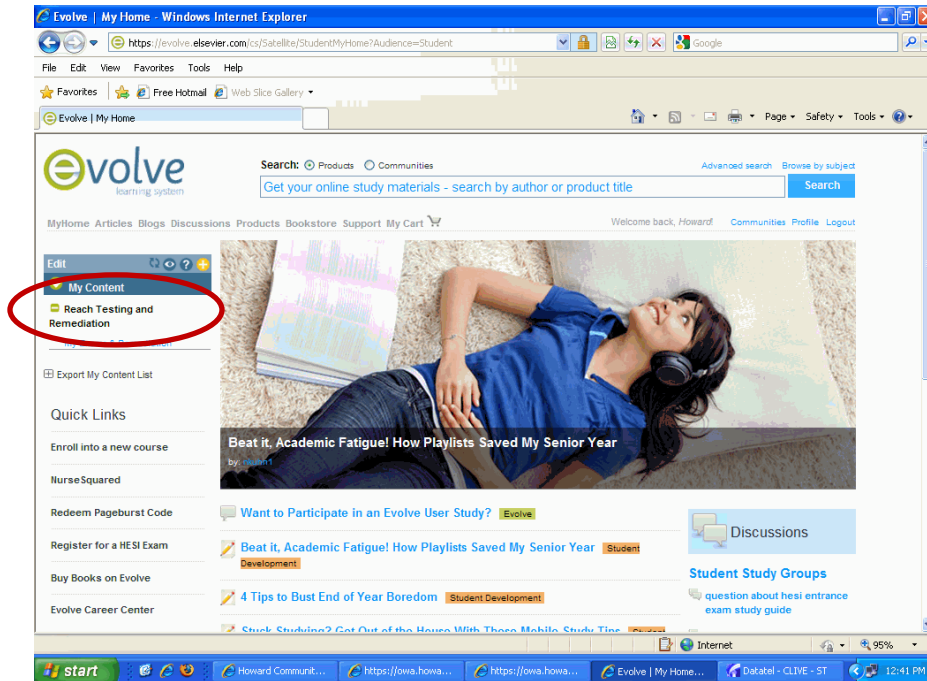
Type in the requested information and click the green “Continue” button.



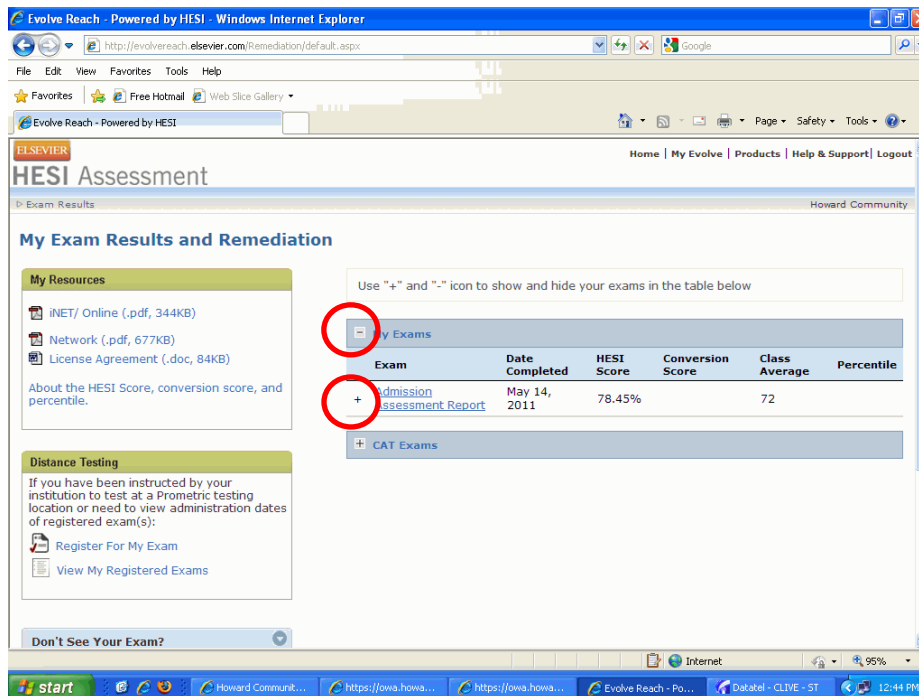
Click to check in the “Yes” box and click the “Submit” button.



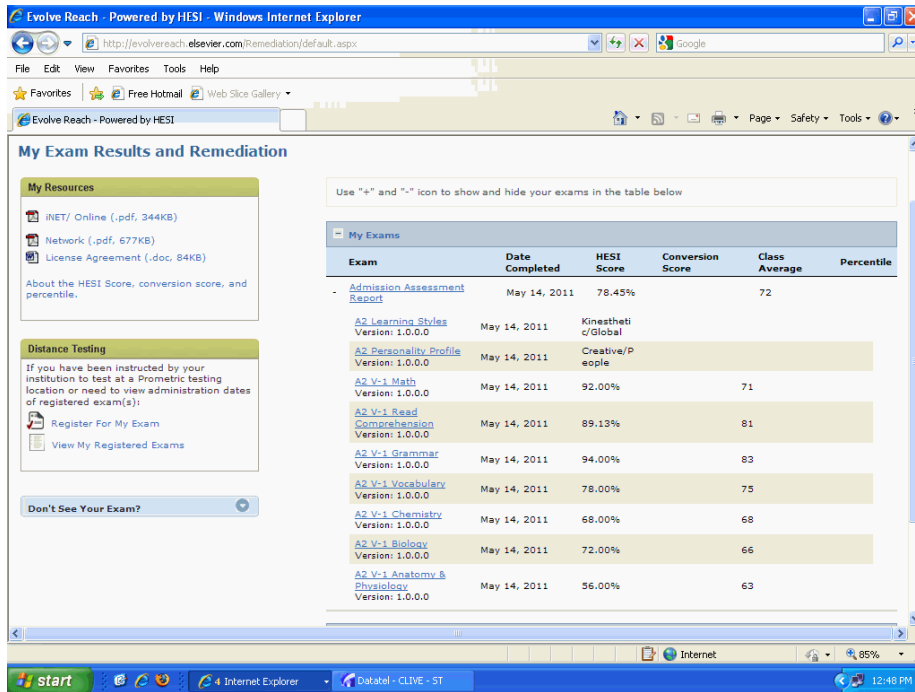
Go to www.evolve.elsevier.com. Select Student Site. Log in. Under My Content, click "Reach Testing and Remediation". Click My Exams and Remediation.



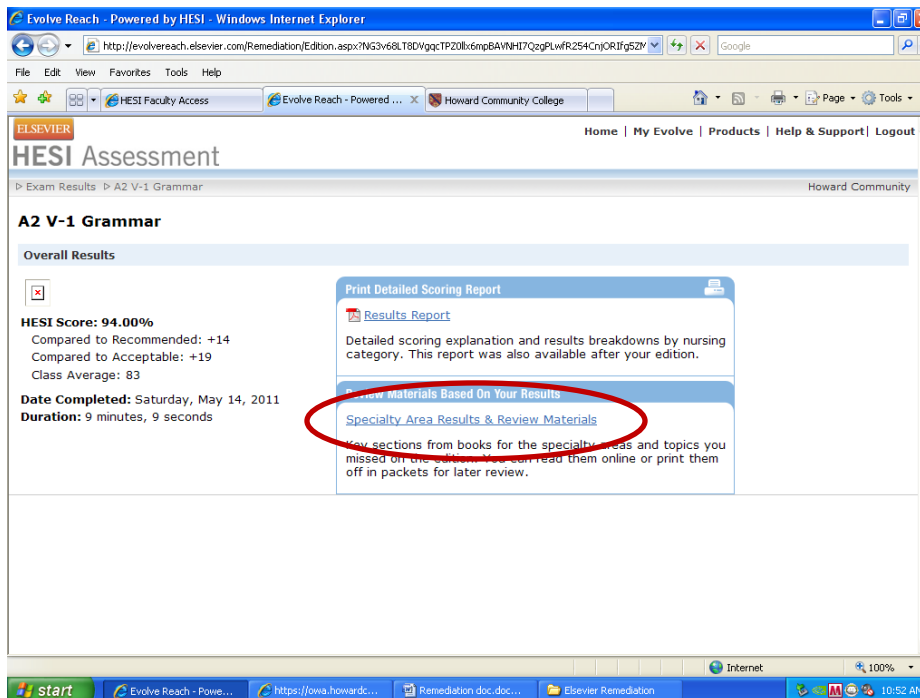

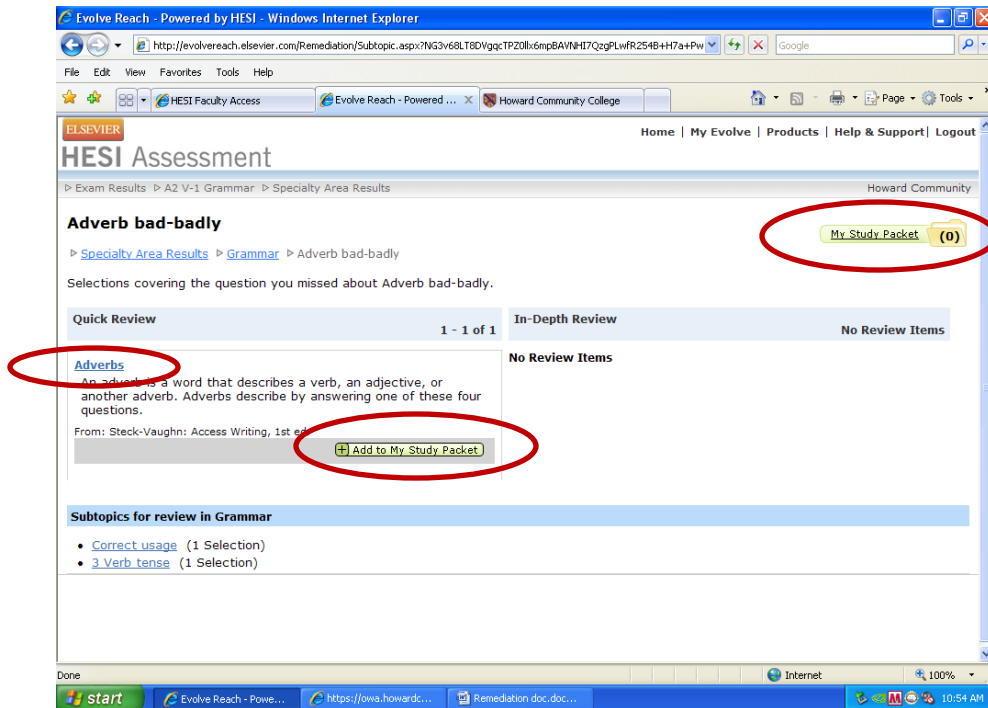
