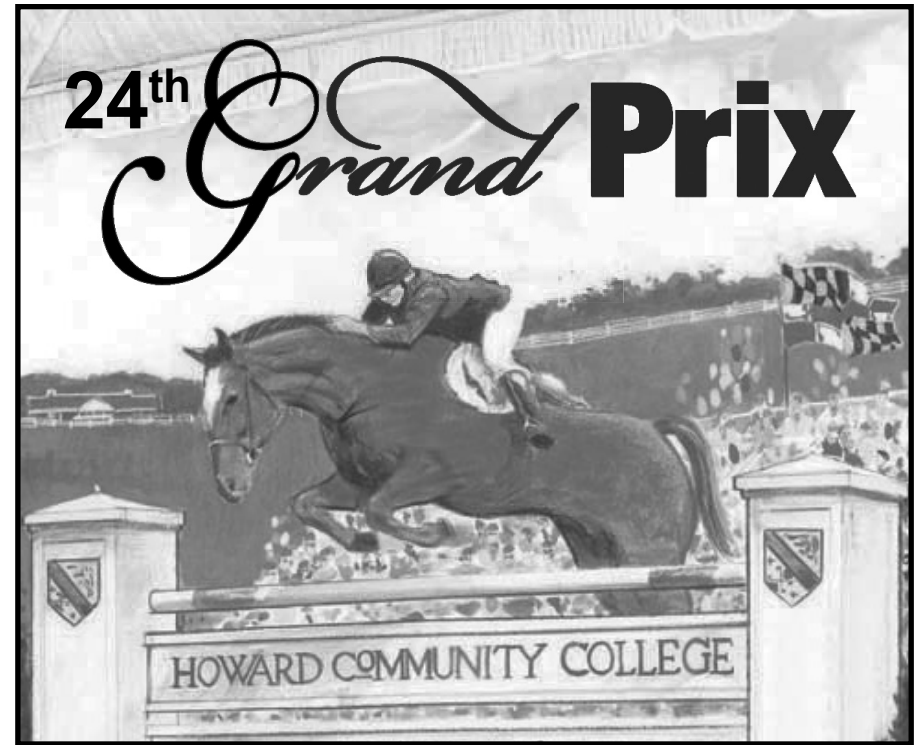

Horses must be nominated and the nominating fee of \$100 paid by the closing date of entries, Monday, September 19, 2011.

The class is to be scored under Table II, Section 2(A), Timed First Jump Off.

Fences set to National Standard.

No rider may show more than three (3) horses in this class.

The starting order will be drawn.

Ties for other than first place will be broken by the first round times.

The Show Committee requires that all participants be formally attired. Riders must wear the following: scarlet, dark blue, dark green, or black coat; white shirt with white tie, white choker or white stock; white, fawn, or canary breeches; hunt cap; black boots. **No exceptions will be permitted.**

Prize money checks will be made out to the owner of record unless otherwise specified on the application form, and a Social Security or Federal ID number is on file.

Prize money: \$10,500, \$7,700, \$4,550, \$2,800, \$2,100, \$1,750, \$1,400, \$1,050, \$1,050, \$700, \$700, \$700.

The grounds for the purpose of stabling will be at Marama Farm, 5610 Chamblis Drive, Clarksville, Maryland 21029. All horses must be on the grounds by 1 p.m., Friday, September 23, 2011. Poling and/or the use of off sets will not be permitted for horses participating in any class for the 24-hour period prior to the Grand Prix.

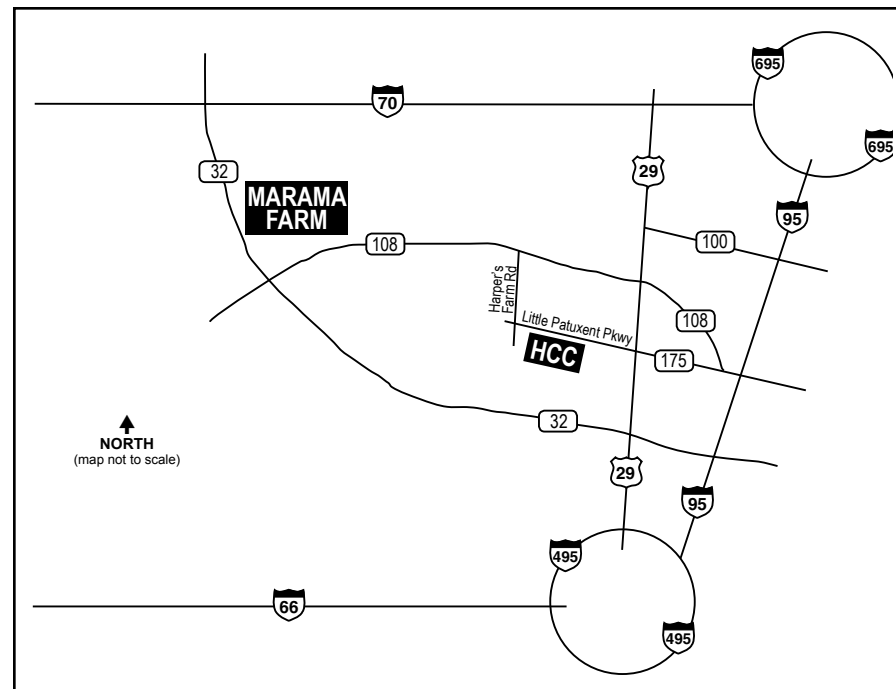

DIRECTIONS TO GRAND PRIX

General Location: Marama Farm lies west of I-95 and Route 29 about halfway between Baltimore and Washington.

I-95, From Points North and South: Take exit 38-B (Route 32 West) toward Columbia. Proceed 9.5 miles, turn **RIGHT** at E. Linden Church Road and **RIGHT** again at Broadwater Lane. After approximately one mile, turn **LEFT** onto Chamblis Drive and proceed one-tenth mile to 5610. Marama Farm is on the right.

I-70, From Points East and West: Take exit 80 (Route 32 South) toward Clarksville. Proceed approximately 7 miles, turn **LEFT** at E. Linden Church Road and **RIGHT** at Broadwater Lane. After approximately one mile, turn **LEFT** onto Chamblis Drive and proceed one-tenth mile to 5610. Marama Farm is on the right.

5. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainers who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainers from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
6. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be submitted to the show committee whose decision will be final.
7. Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries.
8. The committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stabling fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation.
9. All prize money will be paid by check made out to owner of record, unless otherwise specified on the application form, and a Social Security number or federal ID number is on file. Checks will be mailed within seven days of the event.
10. All entry blanks must be completed and signed in accordance with Rule V, Section 2.
11. Proof of negative coggins must accompany entries or be shown to the show secretary when picking up numbers.
12. Temporary stabling with doors will be available on site. Cost is \$175 per night.
13. All Grand Prix horses must be on site by 1 p.m. on Friday, September 23. This will be strictly enforced.
14. No manual poling or offsets are permitted at any time on the grounds.
15. Ring size, 350' x 240'. Grass footing.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
2. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.**
3. All horses showing in jumper classes offering prize money at a competition that offers \$2500 or more in the following section combined (Preliminary, Intermediate, Open, Amateur-Owner, Junior) must be recorded with the USEF except where prohibited by state or local law.
4. The management is not responsible for injury to person or horse at any time, which includes going to, coming from, and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for vehicles, or any article that may be lost or damaged. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to tents and other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

Federation Entry Agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of this competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: I AGREE that "the Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaultor, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment, including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form.
