- Glassdoor.com contains reviews, ratings, company information, salaries, CEO approval rating, competitors, content providers, and more company information. Users can find and anonymously share real-time reviews, ratings and salary details about specific jobs for specific employers.
- An excellent way to get inside information, including how satisfied the employees are, what they see as the pros and cons, and how much they are earning.

Company Information on YouTube

- Interested in finding out more about a company or potential employer? Check to see if the company has a recruiting video on YouTube. You will find videos on job opportunities, interviewing, working at a company, company culture, and benefits.
- There are company videos on YouTube created specifically by employers for recruitment purposes. There are unofficial videos that will give you information, as well.
- Search YouTube by company name or search using keywords like recruiting, recruitment, employer, or hiring. You will need to scroll through the results, but you'll find some video created by companies to help with their recruiting efforts and to give candidates a video perspective on job opportunities, benefits, and company culture.
- Other videos have information on what it's like to work at the company i.e. a day in the life of a company employee or on what's it like to interview at the company.
