She then had the salad weighed and when told of the price, stated she didn't have the money. The cashier threw the salad away. The student paid for the bottle of milk. The student told the cashier, "The problem with you and the black women is that you're jealous of me". The cashier advised the student not to sample from the salad bar. The cashier advised her that she would give her a bowl to sample should she request some in the future.

This episode upset the other customers in the Galley and kept people waiting in line at the cash register.

On 4-28-05 at approximately 12:30 hours, Security was contacted by a student, in reference to an indecent exposure that occurred on 4-22-05. She stated that on Friday, 4-22-05 at approximately 4:30, she was walking to her vehicle which was parked on the student parking lot just west of the bus stop. She stated that she observed a black male standing next to a maroon SUV in a parking space to the rear of where her vehicle was parked. It was in the parking cell separated by the driving lane. She stated that she thought he was trying to break into the vehicle because he was near the gas fill and was facing the vehicle. As she got to her vehicle she states that the individual turned to face her. At this point she could see that he was masturbating. She stated that he had no expression on his face. She described him as a black male, 5-8, thin build, approximately 150 lbs., close cropped black hair, small face, 29-30 years old, dark complexion, wearing light colored jeans and a dark shirt. The vehicle was a burgundy SUV with Maryland registration. .

She stated that she entered her vehicle and left the parking lot. When she looked back, the suspect was bent over at the open passenger door of his vehicle as if he was looking for something in the vehicle.
