On Thursday April 23, 2009 at about 7:30pm the Security department received two simultaneous calls about a stabbing at HCC. The first call was from Howard County Police Department informing security that a stabbing had occurred in the English building at HCC and the police and medics were on the scene. The second call was from Registration informing that they had a black gentleman bleeding from his hand and asking someone to call the ambulance for him. Security reported to Duncan Hall roadside to the police officers and another Security officer reported to the Registration office, where he saw in individual holding his bleeding hand. Security contacted the other officer over the radio informing him about the location of the young gentleman and Security escorted the police and the paramedics to the RCF building. The individual that was stabbed was not an HCC student. According to the information he gave the Howard County Police Officers, he was riding the Howard County green bus line from the Safeway at Harpers Choice Village Center to the Columbia Mall. He was sitting in the back of the bus when he was stabbed by another person whom he did not know. His brother was also on the bus with him. The three of them got off at the HCC bus stop across from the RCF building. The person who stabbed Mr. Corbin-Jones ran through the campus and across the quad. The injured individual entered the RCF building through the main doors on the second floor by the RCF circle and went into registration to seek help. He refused to go to the hospital and the paramedic personnel cleaned his wound and placed a gauze bandage around it.

Security Director began the follow up investigation of this theft by reviewing video tape. The individual advised he placed his white T shirt and cell phone on the seats of the gym bleachers during open gym time. Video supported this information.

Shortly after, the suspect was seen walking to the seats and sat next to the phone and shirt. The suspect left. The individual was the only person going to the area where his phone was located and was seen looking for his property.

Subsequent video was reviewed that followed the suspect leaving and re-entering the gym. His identity was obtained a few days later when a Security Officer on patrol recognized the description. .

The Director of Security interviewed the suspect and he admitted sitting next to the phone but denied stealing it from the bleachers.

The suspect was informed that the matter would be turned over to the police for investigation. On 5/12/09 at 3:00pm, the suspect contacted the Director of Security and advised that he had the phone and would turn it in to Security.

On 5/13/09 the suspect came to the Security Office and gave the phone to the Director of Security. The suspect admitted he took the phone but did not think it was a big deal. He showed little remorse for stealing the phone.

The followup incident report will be sent to Student Services for review of Code of Conduct violation.

The phone was returned to the individual on 5/13/09. No police report or charges placed by the individual.
