<p>Security was approached by a staff member in reference to a student who believed he and his brother were in physical danger. Security accompanied the staff member to another staff member's office. Upon arrival Security was introduced to the student. He advised that he and his brother and wife were threatened by several family members from the wife's family. All incidents occurred at an off campus location. The student's brother and wife were students at HCC during the Spring 2007 semester. They became friends and later fell in love. They subsequently married without family knowledge. The student is Muslim and his wife is Sikh. When her family found out they were very upset. Approximately six family members went to the residence, physically attacked the male and made verbal threats to kill him, his brother and their sister/cousin. Howard County Police responded and took a report. Security advised that he, his brother and wife should go to the District Court in Ellicott City and obtain Ex Parte Orders against the assailants. He advised that some of the assailants are students at HCC. He did not know their names, only nick-names. Security advised him that Security would be able to escort him and his brother from their vehicles to the classroom and then back to the vehicle. The wife is not registered this semester. The male student advised that he would obtain the actual names and call security.</p>
