The individual stated to security that he noticed the suspect walking toward the ELB building. At the same time security was obtaining this information we received a call from the HR security officer about a missing backpack. At this time officer Osman identified the contents of the purse and it belonged to the same person who was missing the back pack. The individual approached officer Shurgalla in the ELB Building and advised him that the suspect was outside of the building in the smoking area. At this time Lt. Hailey advised an employee of the Welcome Center to call Howard County Police. .Officer M. J Gibson responded to the area where the suspect was located after several questions from officer Gibson to the suspect and some conflicting answers officer Gibson became suspicious of the individual and decided to detain him. While searching the suspect the officer found a card that belonged to the victim along with several other items. Security received a call from the Library about some missing property. An individual reported to security that his watch was stolen from the Library. Officer Gibson asked the individual if he could he come and check some of the items that he had removed from the suspect. The individual identified a silver colored watch that he stated was removed from the desk where he was sitting .The suspect was transported to the Jessup station for processing..Case#06-121422. Security checked all parking lots for some of the missing items and managed to locate the majority of the contents that belong to the individual to include checkbook/bankcards and one calculator The individual was notified by security that her checkbook was found and that she could get it from the security office.</p>
