Summary

On date and time stated above, security responded to ILB-110 for a disorderly student. After further investigation security learned that a help desk tech had asked a student not to talk on his cell phone because his conversation was loud enough to disturb the room. The help desk tech stated that she asked him to leave and the student refused. Security approached the student at this time to find out what the problem was and he became loud and disorderly with the security officer. At this time Security asked the student to leave the area. He again became loud and disorderly. Security advised him that if he would not leave the area that Howard County Police would be contacted. The student advised me to go ahead. At this time Security proceeded to call Howard County. While Security was on the phone with the dispatcher, the student put on some type of dance show for the students and left the area. Police responded but the student was nowhere to be found. Police issued a report # 013543 and cleared the area. At approximately 4:45 security again responded to the lab area again for a disorderly student which happened to be the student. Apparently the student had reentered the lab and caused some type of altercation in lab. After further investigation security learned that the student was again in the lab being disorderly and was asked by a student lab aide to quiet down. When the student was told to leave he jumped up and became more louder and again he was told to leave. He began to push the lab aide with his chest, The lab aide pushed the student to get free but he pushed her back into the wall and made some comments promising physical violence and left the area. At this time Security and two additional officer's made a sweep of the ELB building locating the student on the second floor in a classroom. Security knocked on the door and asked the instructor if he could speak with the student for a moment. As Security was talking to the instructor, the student appeared outside of the classroom. As Security was speaking with the student about the incident, he stated that he was assaulted by the lab aide and that he was going to call Howard County police. The student returned to the classroom and gave another show for his classmates stating that he was assaulted and was calling the police. Security explained to the student that he was disrupting his class and that he would have to leave. Again a police officer returned and this time spoke with the student about the incident and also with the lab aide. A case number of #07-13564 was given to both parties for future references. Security also spoke with a witness who stated that she was standing in entrance talking with a friend when the suspect came back into the lab disrupting the lab calling the aide a bitch and asking her what you want to do now and chest bumping her several times. She stated that the aide tried to push him off after that he pushed forcefully against the wall and than ran upstairs to the classroom.
