The two students entered the elevator at approximately 1:43pm and left the elevator at 1:44pm after the first employee re-entered the elevator at 1:44pm. The first employee stated that is when she noticed spit on the buttons. Security began searching for the two students. While approaching the main lobby of the HVPA, Security encountered the two students in the quad. Security instructed the two students to report to the security desk where they could be interviewed. After interviewing the students, both of them denied spitting on the elevator. No further information is available at this time. Video footage is pending.
