<p>On date and time stated above, security received a call from the nursing area about a male subject walking around their area acting suspiciously. Gavalian Hailey) was approached by a female student( who left the area after she told me where the person was located) that a male had followed her to class and was standing outside of the class when she left. After investigating the complaint the person in question turned out to be the same individual. Security advised him at this time he needed to remove himself from college property. <b>Summary</b>			
A Security officer who was assigned at ELB building reported that a vehicle was driving around the campus and it had stopped at least three times at the ELB roadside door. When the vehicle had stopped the third time in front of the building the Security officer noticed a man came out of ELB-110 and sat inside the vehicle. The driver drove away, but the Security officer who was assigned to the mobile unit, also called over the radio in reference to the same vehicle driving around the campus. The Security officer stated that the vehicle in question had been randomly driving to various lots around the campus. After hearing that call Security alerted the unit to search the garage and the parking lots around the campus. The vehicle was located in lot-A (tan color, Maryland tag) Security approached the vehicle from the rear and the driver started his vehicle, Security noticed a lot of movement going on inside the car. As Security approached the drivers side of the vehicle, Security noticed the windows were fogged up and smelled an odor like marijuana, and then Security tapped on the drivers side window. The driver was nervously looking at the Security officer and took a few seconds to open the window. Once the driver opened the window, Security noticed his eyes glassy and bloodshot, and even saw both men had lighted cigars in their hands. Security told the driver that another officer observed this vehicle driving erratically from lot to lot, and			

randomly stopped without any purpose. The driver then replied nervously I'm student here and I'm looking for my classes. The passenger stated that he works in the computer lab ELB-110 as a tech. Based on what Security smelled and observed Security believed both occupants of the vehicle were under the influence of marijuana or a variant of the same. Security asked both gentlemen to leave the campus and both complied. Approximately five minutes later Mobile -1 observed the same vehicle in lot E. Mobile unit reported that no one was inside the car. Based on that, Security met at ELB-110. Once inside both occupants of the vehicle were found to be behind the IT-Help Desk. Once again Security noticed that both of the gentlemen's eyes were bloodshot and both of the individuals smelled of marijuana. Security asked one of the individuals if he was working and he replied that he was. Security stated to the individual that he had two choices; One call your boss and tell them what happened and leave or Security would call the police. Frightfully, and hurriedly both gentlemen decided to leave. The individual struggled as he was trying to get up from the chair, and walked unsteadily outside the building with the driver of the vehicle. Mobile-one ensured that the vehicle exited the premises, and this incident was resolved approximately 2115. Security's actions taken were based on appearance of heavy smoke inside the car, smell of heavy odor like marijuana ,bloodshot eyes ,cigars in both gentlemen's anxious and frighten actions of both parties
