<p>On January 11, 2012 at 10:49am, Security was dispatched to respond to a verbal altercation near ST 129. A health sciences faculty member stated that the altercation was between a male and a female and the male was very persistent on getting the female's attention. Security arrived on scene where we spoke with the health science division chair that was with the male student. Security spoke with the male student while the other officer spoke with the female student. The female student stated that she and the male are friends and they got into an altercation earlier today. She also stated that he followed her from the ST garage to attempt to resolve the problem but she just wanted him to leave her alone and she told him several times.</p> <p>The male student stated that the reason for the argument was that he went to pick up the female and he wasn't aware that her friend would be there, so he became frustrated with the friend. After speaking with Security, the male student left campus until his 1pm class and the female was offered an escort from Security personnel, but she refused. No further information provided.</p>

On January 11, 2012 at 12:32pm, Security was dispatched to N115 to escort a disruptive student from class. Security arrived at N115 and spoke with the instructor. The instructor stated that the student was being belligerent and did not want to give her any information (first, last name). The student agreed to exit the class with Security to explain her side of the story. The student stated that she was just explaining the homework policy to the person sitting beside her and the instructor told her to get out.

After class ended at 12:45pm, the student that was sitting beside the other student wrote a statement saying "the instructor was explaining to the class about the late homework policy. The student turned to the other student and started telling her about the policy. The instructor told the student to stop talking and that she will explain the policy. The student kept talking and the instructor told her if she does not stop talking out of term she will have to leave. The student started arguing with the instructor and the instructor called security.

Security spoke with the instructor before class ended and she informed security that she would write her statement and she would call Security as soon as she was finished. Security arrived at the instructor's office to retrieve her typed statement along with her course syllabus and a Canvas announcement email which she sends to all of her students. <p>On Friday, January 13, 2012 at approximately 7:25pm, Security was dispatched to DH116 for a medical emergency. Upon arriving at the scene, Security observed a student lying on the bench located across from DH116 with several students around her and a faculty member. The student appeared to be disoriented and dizzy. Security asked the student if she needed medical attention but she did not respond. At 7:30pm, Security notified dispatch that they would be calling 911. The student sat up on the bench and vomited. The 911 operator suggested laying the student on her side until paramedics arrived at the scene. At 7:35pm fire and rescue arrived at DH roadside. They immediately took a medical assessment and proceeded to transport the student to Howard County General hospital. Fire and Rescue left campus at 7:45pm. No further information at this time.</p>

On January 29, at approximately 3:30pm, an individual reported to Security that he was verbally assaulted on campus grounds. On Tuesday, January 31, at approximately 11:41am, Security was dispatched to respond to the second floor in the Hickory Ridge building to the women's restroom for a student who had reportedly fainted. Security arrived on the scene minutes later, while the student was sitting down in HR 200 with faculty members assisting her. At this time, the student was alert and conscious. The student stated that she became nauseous around 11:30am so she went to the bathroom because she had to vomit. While in the bathroom she fell to the ground and became unconscious for approximately thirty seconds. During this time, another student witnessed the student fall to the ground. She assisted her on the ground and then notified an instructor who called 911. The student stated she had this problem two years ago and that her parents knew about her previous condition. She also explained that she had not eaten anything for the day. Paramedics arrived on the scene to follow up with the student's medical condition.
