<p>On date and time stated above, Security received a call from the Project Access Director requesting assistance from security stating that she needed a disruptive student removed from the classroom. Security responded to said location. As Security was approaching the classroom, we observed several students leaving the classroom with the Director behind them. When the Director approached Security, the officer asked her what was the problem and she began telling me that she didn't need any reinforcement from security. The Security officer attempted to explain to her that when she stated there was a disruptive student in her classroom when we spoke on the phone, that precautions with a show of enforcement could prevent any possible physical contact on part of the student. In order to relieve the discussion, the Security officer instructed the other officers to remain in the hallway while the first officer proceeded to the classroom. When the officer entered the classroom, he observed the student sitting in his chair crying. He was not disruptive at that time, The officer was able to calm him down to the point where he could obtain his name/phone number/and the area which he lived. The only other matters he would discuss was his medical condition (Bi-Polar) The Security officer eventually had him leave the classroom with another officer and sat in the lobby until he became settled and calm. An officer from the 4pm-12 shift escorted the student to the restroom to take his medication and returned to the classroom without further incident.</p>
