On Friday, July 17, 2009, two individuals were spotted by Security in Duncan Hall at about 5:07 peeping into classrooms looking for someone. When they were approached by Security, the one individual questioned Security's authority of asking them for their student ID due to suspicious activity. Security was able to get one individual's ID and with his cooperation, Security found out that they were looking for the individual's younger brother who was in accupuncture. The case was resolved with both individuals that they would wait in Duncan Hall for the younger brother. While in Duncan Hall, I S/O Siddiqui witnessed Mr. Coleman yelling across the lobby with another individual wearing a red shirt sitting by the computers. Words were being exchanged and I asked Mr. Coleman to step behind Duncan Hall in the smoking section and explain the situation to me. According to Mr. Coleman's statement, the individual who was later identified as Kahili Drummond, made threats against Mr. Coleman's life and his family. Mr. Coleman is identified as a young black male age 23, wearing a white t-shirt/ blue cargo pants and was carrying a wrench in his back pocket. I advised Mr. Coleman to stay away from Drummond to avoid any conflict. Both Mr. Coleman and Mr. Moore decided to wait for Andrew Moore by road side of Duncan Hall. As Lt. Osman passed by I and Mr. Coleman explained to him about the situation, Mr. Coleman said he was calm, and was not going to initiate any behavior unless Mr. Drummond decided to fight him. Mr. Moore and Mr. Coleman proceeded to the DH lobby where Mr. Drummond was no longer there and they waited for Andrew by the computers. A while later at approximately 18:05 as I was patrolling the outside of the DH building I noticed Mr. Coleman talking with a police officer by the roadside of Duncan Hall. I called Lt. Osman through the radio to inform him of the car on campus. Sgt. Khan and Mr. Hailey also responded to the scene where Mr. Coleman was was speaking with the law enforcement(Officer Grenfell). Mr. Coleman explained the same statement to the officer which he had told myself and Lt. Osman earlier. Mr. Hailey inquired about Mr. Coleman's status as a student and since he was no longer a student, Mr. Cloeman was asked to leave the campus immediately. As Mr. Coleman was leaving campus, Mr. Drummond approached the security officers and Officer Grenfell stepped out of the car to keep the situation at hand from escalating and took down Mr. Drummonds information as well. Mr. Drummond had approached Sgt. Khan in the securityoffice earlier about Mr. Coleman threatening him and having a wrench. The Officer stated that their was an earlier incdent off campus involving both individuals(case #0973399). Mr. Drummond stated a different story that Mr. Coleman made threats against himand was following him at his work and to school. The case was resolved when the officer asked Mr. Coleman to leave the campus along with Mr. Moore. Soon after Mr. Drummond left.
