Approximately 15 minutes later the alarm sounded off again causing some people to evacuate the building and some to stay in their classroom. Security was advised by the Plant Operations staff member that there was no need to evacuate until we heard from him. Several classes relocated to the E.L.B. building for the remainder of their class time while plant operations were maintaining the problem. At approx. 7:12pm security was advised by another Plant Operations staff member that the panel was shut down and security would have to maintain a fire watch through the night.

While Security was patrolling the first floor of the ELB, Security heard someone shouting at them from the second floor. The individual stated that he needed assistance. When Security approached him on the second floor he asked Security if I was "born again". The individual then started shouting out religious sayings and speaking in an unknown language. As he was speaking he moved closer to the Security officer. The Security officer felt threatened and asked him to calm down. He then started pacing back and forth. Security called for assistance and the Director of Security and his assistant responded. The Director of Security asked the individual if he was a student and he replied that he was. The Director of Security asked him for his student ID but he stated he did not have it with him.
