<b>Summary</b>			
Security was contacted by the Nursing and Health Laboratory Manager, in reference to an incident that occurred on the second floor of the Nursing Building. She stated that at approximately 8:05, she was walking outside N-232 in the hallway when she sensed that someone was on her left side. When she looked, she identified the individual. The individual stated, "I guess you'll have time to talk to me at River Hill High when you are away from work". The staff member stated, "Excuse me, what did you say?" The staff member's son attends River Hill High School) She turned around and went back to N-232 to call security. She stated that the individual continued on in the same direction he was walking and exited through the door near the snack area. The staff member advised that she has a history with this individual. In early February 2005, a faculty member reported to her that this student, was in N-228 sitting at one of the computers. The faculty member stated that the individual was not a current cardiovascular student and should not be using the computer lab. The staff member went into N-228 and asked the individual if he was a current allied health student. He stated that he was a former student. The staff member explained to him that the Nursing and Allied Health computer lab was open to current Nursing and Allied Health students. He acknowledged and left the lab. Approximately two weeks later, the staff member discovered the individual in N-228. This was approximately 7:45 to 8:00. She asked him if he was a current Nursing and Allied Health student and he stated			

"No". She asked him if he was a current student at HCC and he stated he was in a HEED class. The staff member advised him that he could use the open computer lab in the ILB. The individual then stated "You better evaluate your faculty here, their inadequacies, you need to do something about it." She asked him what he meant and he stated "The cardiovascular faculty, you know the inside scoop". She advised him that she was not the appropriate person to discuss the matter with, that he would have to follow the proper channels that are outlined in the Student Handbook. She also advised him that he would have to leave the lab. The individual stated, "Here you are, making a student leave the lab". The staff member advised him that if he didn't leave the lab, she would call security. While he was in the process of leaving, he stated in a loud voice, "This is not the last time you will see me". The staff member left N-228 and went to N-232. The individual approached her in N-232 and stated, "You will see me again". The staff member advised that she told him he was acting inappropriately and that she would contact security if he did not stop his inappropriate behavior and leave the lab area. The individual left and was not observed by the staff member until 3-17-05.
