### Summary

Security received a call in reference to a disturbance on the roadway outside of the ILB. Upon arrival Security observed two individuals engaged in a verbal argument. The one individual was identified as the driver of the shuttle service. The other was a student who is also employed in Plant Operations. There was a third individual, the mail carrier, who was attempting to remove the student from the scene. As Security approached the two men, Security heard the student saying "I don't give a \*\*\*\*" and using other profanity. The student got onto the Gator (Green cart) and left the area. The shuttle driver returned to the shuttle bus. He related that he was proceeding eastbound on the driveway approaching the drop-off in front of the ILB. He stated that he observed the Gator parked in the middle of the driveway blocking his passage. He observed the student in the wooded area between the ILB and Parking Lot "A". The student was picking up trash. The shuttle driver asked the student to move the Gator so he could proceed to the drop-off area at the ILB. The shuttle driver stated that the student told him that he could make it past the Gator. He could not negotiate past the Gator. At this point, a staff member exited her seat, leaned over the driver and advised the student that she was going to report him to Plant Operations. She further states that the student became belligerent and volatile and told her that she was unprofessional. She states that the student proceeded to the passenger side of the bus and it is her opinion that he wanted to get on the bus to confront her. The shuttle driver would not open the door. The student returned to the driver's side and continued to argue with the driver. Eventually, the staff member and several others exited the bus and walked to the ILB. As she was walking away, she noticed that the driver had exited the bus and talking with the student.. She states that the shuttle driver conducted himself very professionally and tried to diffuse the situation

Another staff member was also a witness to the incident. She states that she was walking towards the ILB and observed the two men arguing. She states that she heard profanity being used. When she observed the driver exit the bus, she called Security.

Another staff member also witnessed the altercation. She states that the shuttle driver was polite in his conversation with the student.. The student refused to move the Gator. She states that when the other staff member advised the student that she was going to report him to Plant Operations he became very irate.

Another staff member also witnessed the incident. She states that she observed the shuttle driver exit his vehicle and confront the Plant Operations employee. She states that both

individuals were using a profanity during the confrontation.

Another staff member also witnessed the incident. She advises that she was walking between Parking Lot "A" and the ILB when she observed the shuttle bus and the Gator parked on the driveway blocking traffic. She observed both men outside their vehicles engaged in a heated argument. When she observed both men taking off their jackets, she called Security. She observed a staff member run over to the individuals and try and calm them down. She states that the staff member tried to get the student to leave the area. She advised that the student was the instigator/aggressor. She states that he was using the harshest language and he was the one the staff member had to get in front of to keep him from fighting. She further states that the student kept getting out of his vehicle to exchange harsh words when he had the opportunity to just drive away.

Security interviewed the student on 3-2-06. He states that he stopped to get trash. He feels he left enough room for vehicles to get by. He states that he told the shuttle driver to continue past him. He states that he felt threatened by the facial expressions and tone of the shuttle driver. He further stated that after the lady threatened to report him to Plant Operations, he moved his vehicle.

In conclusion, the evidence of the witnesses points toward the student as the prime culprit in this incident. There is one witness who heard profanity coming from the shuttle driver. The incident could have been avoided had the student simply moved his vehicle out of the way of the shuttle bus. Conversely, the shuttle driver should have remained on the bus, not getting off and further escalating the argument.

Security spoke with the supervisor of the student. He advised that he has requested counseling and a letter of apology from the student addressed to all individuals involved. The supervisor has arranged for the student to receive counseling for Anger Management and conflict in the work place.

**Summary**

The student was complaining of stomach discomfort and difficulty breathing. One of the staff called the Nursing Division and a faculty member responded to the scene. The faculty member assessed the student and advised that 911 should be called. Howard County Fire and Rescue Paramedic Unit 95 responded. The paramedic checked her vital signs, then prepared her for transport to Howard County General Hospital. The student's parents were notified by the staff of the division office.

**Summary**

Security was stationary at parking lot E writing input into the daily journal when an individual approached the vehicle. The individual frantically threw himself onto the driver door of the mobile vehicle saying he needed help. Security immediately rolled down the driver's side window slightly and asked the individual if he was alright. He said he had been robbed. Security urged him to stand still, then the security officer contacted base notifying them that they had an emergency and requested the assistance of bravo 1, to parking lot E.

As Security was speaking to base, the individual continued to explain what had happened to him. Security noticed the Executive Vice President walking to her vehicle, then Security noticed the individual move from a standing position to laying in a prone position on the ground beside the mobile vehicle. Security immediately contacted base and requested 911 assistance. Immediately after security's request for 911 assistance, the individual got up off the ground. Security noticed the Executive Vice President in her vehicle, which was now parallel to the mobile vehicle facing the opposite direction. The Executive Vice President asked the Security officer if they was okay, The Security officer told her yes, that they was waiting on assistance. The individual was still talking and making small steps back and forth beside the mobile vehicle. Another Security officer arrived on scene and exited the mobile vehicle to assist in questioning the individual.

The individual reported he was walking outside of the athletic building when he was approached by three males . One black male with dread locks, one white male (small physical build) and one white male (fat in physical build.) The individual stated that one of the males asked him for a cigarette and as he began to reply one of the individuals struck him over his head with a bottle. The individual reported that he was robbed of \$2,500 and he had \$5,000 in his sock.

Security requested to see the individual's identification at which time the individual did present his driver's license and bus pass. Security asked the individual if he wanted to make an official report and he denied assistance from the police and did not want to make an official report.

Approximately 7 48 another security officer arrived on scene. Security arrived on scene and assumed control of the situation. Security asked the individual if he wanted the police to help and did he want to make an official report. The individual denied both. The individual then stated that as soon as Security gave him his identification back, he would go to the bus stop and catch the next bus to go see his mother and sister, who he had not seen in 8 years.

Security gave the individual's identification back and Security instructed him to make his way to the bus stop. The individual immediately began walking towards the campus bus stop.

Security entered the mobile vehicle and made a roll by the bus stop and noticed the individual sitting on the ground in front of the bus shelter area. Security approached the individual and Security questioned the individual to see if he was certain he didn't want to make an official report and to ensure he was fine. He stated again he did not want either offers and related that he had just flown into BWI a few days ago and was on his way to see his mother and sister, whom he had not seen in eight years when he was robbed on campus. Security confirmed the individual was calm and waiting on the bus. Security exited the immediate area.

Security patrolled the bus area within a matter of 1 minute and noticed a bus had stopped but the individual did not board the bus. Security immediately notified Bravo 2 and instructed to have the Howard County police contacted to request their presence to take over the situation as the individual now became a suspicious individual on HCC campus.

Security drove the mobile vehicle to parking lot F. While waiting for the police to arrive, Security observed the individual as he lingered at the bus stop. Approximately 3 minutes later as the individual boarded a bus the HC police patrol arrived and Security informed the officer of the situation.

The officer followed the bus route and HCC officers ended assistance with the situation.

### Summary

Security received a phone call from an individual stating that he wanted to report a theft that occurred in the Athletic and Fitness Center.

He stated that he inadvertently dropped his wallet while dressing in the men's locker room. He stated that he left the locker room at 12:10. At approximately 12:30, an unknown white male brought the wallet to the Athletic Center administrative office. The staff member subsequently delivered the wallet to a staff member at the front kiosk. The staff member stated that when he looked at the identification in the wallet, he realized that he knew the individual as he is a frequent user of the facility. At approximately 1:15, the individual with he missing wallet, wife passed the front kiosk. The staff member gave the wallet to her. When she gave the wallet to her husband, he discovered that all the cash had been removed. He stated that the wallet contained \$152.00.

The individual stated that there were two other individuals in the same locker area during his time in the locker room.

1. W-M, approximately 55 years old, 6', 170 lbs, salt and pepper hair.

2. B-M, 18-20 years old. 5'6", 160 lbs, shoulder length curly hair, flashy black Nike shoes, red, white and blue top, dark shorts. This individual was using the locker next to the individual. The individual is assigned locker # 5.

Security checked with a staff member as to the identity of the individual who is assigned locker #

3. She advised that it was a student at HCC. The other individual could not be identified. Security advised the Athletic Center staff that if they observed the student, to tell him to contact Security. On 3-15-06 at approximately 10:00, the student contacted Security. He stated that he had a gym class that day. He advised that he did not observe the wallet.
