<p>Security reported that a student had contacted him in the ELB and advised that another student had attempted to kiss her on the lips. The incident occurred on 2-28-07 at approximately 3:30. The Director of Security advised the Security Officer to contact the student and have her report to the security office for further investigation. The Security Officer called her and she stated that she could not report to security until 3-7-07 at 3:30. On 3-7-07 at 10:00 hours, the Security Officer revealed that there was further information in reference to this case. He advised that the accused did in fact kiss the victim and had also engaged in sexual contact with the victim.</p> <p>On 3-7-07 at 3:30, the student reported to security for an interview. She stated that on 2-28-07 at approximately 3:30 hours, another student attempted to kiss her on the lips. Later that same day at approximately 5:00, as the student was walking to a tutoring class when she was accosted by the male student in the Quad. At this time he did kiss her on the lips. On 3-6-07 she stated that he was waiting for her outside her classroom on the third floor of the Rouse Company Foundation Building. He followed her to another part of the third floor where he placed his hands under her clothing and touched her breasts and vaginal area. He then asked her to follow him to the computer lab in the ELB. He took her to a stairwell in the ELB where he rubbed his genitalia against her leg and asked her to touch his genitalia. She stated she was frightened of him and complied.</p> <p>Numerous attempts have been made to contact the male student at his Grandmother's home as well as his mother's place of employment with negative results.</p>
