She pointed him out and he was later identified.</p> <p>The witness was disturbed by the earlier incident and gave her account. She was in the same cube area as the suspect who was on the computer viewing what she said was animated sex. He appeared to have his hand under a jacket which was on his lap.</p> <p>She said it appeared he was masturbating and then put his hand, which contained semen, to his mouth.</p> <p>The Security Director attempted to interview the suspect. He is Korean and there was a huge language barrier. A staff member from Con Ed was contacted who agreed to interpret to obtain the student's name and account of the incident. At this same time the student's older brother, came to the office after a call from the suspect. He spoke a little English and was able to discuss the matter with his brother. The suspect admitted to his brother that he was on the computer viewing porn by searching via "Infomaster" (this information was turned over to the IT department for review). The brother said that the suspect has a "habit" of putting his hands in his pants.</p> <p>Suspect was advised to contact Student Services for a meeting regarding Code of Conduct violations. It is recommended that a male Korean interpreter be present to get complete and truthful account of incident.</p>
