**Summary**

A student approached the security office in reference to a report of harassment. She stated to security that in the fall of 2003 when she was in the library a male student passed by her several times, so she stopped attending the library. In the fall of 2004 the male student stated that they had a thing going on, she stated that when she confronted him about it he denied the whole thing. In the fall of 2005 while attending psychology and chemistry classes she stated that he acted like he was trying to help her by giving advice not to take to many classes. He wrote a note on her vehicle stating he loves her, he also e-mailed her stating that we should have lunch. She stated that she told him numerous times that she was not interested in e-mails or him in person and told him not to do it again and that's how rumors are spread. In the spring of 2006 she stated that there was an incident when her face book was broken into and the status was changed along with pictures in the face book. She stated that she did not know if it was the male student but stated that it was very suspicious that an invitation was sent to him. In the spring of 2007 while in the study room in the ELB-building the male student approached her stating to her the he heard that she was talking about him behind his back so she ignored him and shut the door. On 5/11/07 at approx. 2:30pm another female reported to the security office also reported that the male student approached her and asked her if she wanted to be his friend. She stated that they met in the Agape Christian club meetings'. She stated to security that he calls her at odd hours of the day, meets her at a class and she said that he she never gave him her class schedule. She also stated that he had followed her to her vehicle stating that (He got a vision from God that she was supposed to be his wife) she advised him that she would report him to security if he did not stop. At this time he has made no other contact with her.

**Disposition** At approx. 4:30pm on 5/12/07 the first female student notified Howard County Police in reference to a harassment report that she had filed with H.C.C. security department on 5/10/07. A police officer arrived on campus and issued a report number.

<b>Summary</b>			
Security was informed by continuing education office of a stranger in the area. Security was given a description of a black male with black hair and dressed in all black who claimed that he was with the Howard County Fire Department and that he was here to check the sprinkler system in the building. Neither a plant operations employee nor anyone from continuing education or the security department had any knowledge of anyone from the fire department or any sprinkler system company in the area for that purpose. The director of Security notified Howard County Police at approx 4:20 pm who arrived at the Hickory Ridge Building and talked with several people in the continuing education office. There were several conflicting descriptions given of the subject but mainly that he was a black male approximately 40years of age medium height and build and clean shaven was seen going through the continuing education office and several inner offices. Caps were removed from sprinkler heads in the ceilings of continuing education and second and third floor corridors'. A staff member also reported that \$60.00 was missing from her purse. The police officer dusted several offices in the in the area for fingerprints and other physical evidence. He also informed me that the Police Dept. if not himself would be in contact with the college concerning the case #07-44504.
