<p>On date and time stated above, an individual slipped out of her seat and was having seizure symptoms. Afterwards, two students informed Security of what happened. Security then notified their supervisor who in turned called 911. Mobile 1 also responded to assist. Once paramedics arrived (unit 75) the individual was responsive and not feeling any symptoms. She told the paramedics that she didn't have a history of seizures and the only medical problems she had was cholesterol issues. She also refused medical assistance in which she had to sign a form to verify that she didn't want help. Mobile 2 and bravo-7 also responded to location and the Crisis Communication Manager was informed of the incident.</p>

A male student stated that a female was talking to another student about someone else when she suddenly began telling the person she was talking to that she knew the male from church. The male stated the female began saying things about and to him. He responded by telling the female not to say anything to him, since she had been arguing with another student. He stated the female began calling him names and asked him if he wanted to fight her. He stated he tried to back away from her. She then continued to confront him and made an attempt to knock his cell phone from his hand and, in doing so hit him in the face. He then called the female a \*\*\*\*\* which aggravated her more. Security saw the male walking back and forward until the officer was able stop him. In order to calm the situation, Security escorted the male individual inside and asked him to sit outside of the Security office and to give his account of which lead up to this incident.

Information obtained by the Security officer:

On date noted above at approximately 11:30 a female student stated that she was near the RCF building in the Quad and was talking with a male that was standing in group of approximately nine male students. She stated that while she was talking with this male, another male standing in the group said to the male (Don't talk with her she is on my man's \*\*\*\*) The female stated that she began to argue with the male because she felt that he disrespected her and was trying to impress the group of males. Other than arguing nothing else happened between both parties. Security also interviewed a witness that was standing there as this situation developed which of whom stated the same things that the female stated.

While Security was dealing with this incident, the officer noticed that the group of male students that were standing around during this altercation were the same group of males that were standing around during the incident that took place on 10/30/08 at 12:30pm (disorderly conduct) with the exception to the suspect that was involved in this altercation. Security did not observe him on the scene on 10/30/08

While on routine patrol Security observed an individual lying down on the floor sleeping in front of Room 334 in the ELB building. The security officer immediately notified his supervisor and advised him of the situation. The security officer was instructed not to approach the suspect until the supervisor arrived at the location. The officer along with the supervisor arrived at the location immediately. Security woke the individual up and asked him his reason of being on campus so late. He replied that he was in the building since 7:00pm trying to use the computer room to send his professor an e-mail about taking an exam he missed earlier that day. Apparently the room was crowded, so he decided to wait and ended up crashing on the floor. It occurred to the security officers that he wasn't allowed on campus, as they remembered his face from a report in the main Security office. He was then verified and confirmed to be the student not allowed on campus. The security officer then called Howard County Police who arrived at 12:48. The police officers interrogated the individual who stated that he did not have an exact address where he lives and that he doesn't have any relatives around and no contact with his parents. The officer's tried to contact local shelters, but they were all closed at this time of night. The police then advised the individual not to stay on campus past 11:00pm and to contact the Associate Vice President of Student Development about being allowed back on campus. He was also told that he he could get arrested the next time he is found late on campus. It appears that there is an incident report on file for this individual written on 10/10/08. Unfortunately since there was no place to take the individual, he was escorted out of the building which he did by leaving the campus.

On 11/24/08, an individual from Plant Operations came to the RCF Security building and stated "your not going to believe this." Security along with the Plant Operations staff member went into the Security's Director office. The staff member had a DVD which he placed in the Director of Security's computer. Upon viewing the video footage Security observed the following: On Sunday at approx.1:15 the white Mobile 1 traveling west on lot-E struck an emergency pole. The Mobile bent the pole, knocking off the blue light. The Officer driving the Mobile exited the vehicle and observed the damage to the pole and the vehicle. Mobile 2 arrived at the site of the accident and spoke to Mobile 1. At approximately 1:30, both vehicles left the scene. Upon inspecting the vehicle there was obvious blue paint from the pole on Mobile 1's bumper. The investigation is ongoing and any information will be given to the Plant Operations staff. An employee of Allied Barton will contact his supervisor and explain what happened once the identity of the drivers are known.

On Tuesday, November 25, a security officer was interviewed in reference to the above accident. He stated he was posted in the Main building while the electricity was out in the Main Building. As the building powered up, he started to patrol and came across another Security officer. The other Security officer stated that he had been in an accident. He said he fell asleep while driving and crashed into an Emergency Contact Blue Pole in parking lot-E. Both the Lieutenant and Officer inspected the blue pole and the vehicle. They noticed on the vehicle minor scratches and the blue pole leaning over, but not on the ground.

On Tuesday November 25, the Security Officer was interviewed in reference to the above accident. He stated that on the date in question, when he arrived for work, he asked the Lieutenant if he could have a building rather than Mobile patrol. He said that the Lieutenant explained that no one else could work Mobile. The Security Officer also stated he was feeling under the weather and he took NyQuil. The Security Officer stated that he was driving through E lot when he fell asleep at the wheel and crashed into the blue pole. Immediately after the accident he said he contacted the Lieutenant and asked to meet with him to explain the situation. Upon arrival, the Leutenant and the Security Officer inspected the blue pole and Mobile according to the Security Officer. Afterwards, the Security Officer said that the Lieutenant instructed him to go to the office to write a report. The Security Officer said he wrote the report and then spoke with the Lieutenant by radio, which of whom told him to go to Hickory Ridge for the remainder of the shift. Nothing further was stated.

He said "you are wrong let me show you something" and then he proceeded by showing her his private part through his pants. She told him what the\*\*\*\*, are you out of your mind." He said "do you see yourself with a black guy in the future because I see you as my girl." She said "you are crazy" and walked away. She was shocked, disgusted and started crying and called her boyfriend.
