Security was advised by the Director of Security that an assault had occurred in the game room. A security officer responded to same and was met by the game room assistant. She stated, that on 10/02/06 at approx, 1:00, she was seated in the game room as is the norm. She overheard a commotion, turned around and observed two black males exiting the game room in a hurriedly manner. Security's investigation revealed that on 10/02/06 at approx 1:15, two students, one the victim and the other, the suspect, were horse playing in the game room. The suspect struck the victim in the testicles with a pool cue. The suspect ran out of the game room followed by the victim. On 10/06/06 at approx 12:30, Security interviewed the suspect, who admitted to the assault but stated that it was done in fun and without malice. Security then interviewed the victim, who stated he had not been injured at the time of the assault but would no longer engage in any kind of horseplay. On 10/06/06 at approx 2:15, Security viewed the closed circuit TV camera tapes, that were located in the game room. The tapes recorded the suspect holding the pool cue, but failed to record the assault because of the camera's angle. The victim did not wish to file any criminal charges but both would be held accountable for breaking the policies of the college.

Upon arrival, Security was contacted by a student and employee of Riparius) who advised that he had been assaulted. Further investigation revealed that this individual was walking a female student from the north ELB door to the Reparius construction site. They made a right turn on the sidewalk and were walking along the side of the ELB when a black male approached this individual and stated "Let me holla at you". The individual tried to ignore the individual, but he pursued the student. He then stated "I heard you was ***** with my girlfriend".
