<p>At approximately 9:07 on Thursday October 1, 2009 a faculty member was leaving Duncan Hall when her ex-husband began following and verbally harrassing her on her way to her Ford Freestar parked in a handicap space outside of RCF. According to the faculty member, her ex-husband was calling her name loudly and she was responding by saying "You do not talk to me; I do not want to talk to you." When they reached the car, her ex-husband would not allow her to close the door once she got in. She yelled at him to get away. But he forcefully pushed her face to the side, and stated that you're going to regret this. On Friday, October 2, 2009, the faculty member received a Temporary Protective Order from Howard County District Court, stating that her ex-husband is not permitted to visit or approach her at her place of employment, residence, etc. The protective order is valid thru October 8, 2009 pending further investigation. The faculty member stated that she was delayed in reporting the incident because she was flustered on Thursday night, and she wanted to file a complaint with District Court. Security assured the faculty member that we will take all the necessary precautions to keep her safe while she is on campus, including but not limited to watching for her ex-husband; escorting her to and from her car on days she teaches; and any measures deemed necessary. The faculty member will call when she arrives on campus and will travel with an officer to the specific room for that day. A picture of her ex-husband is included with this report.</p>
