**Summary**

On 9-23-05 at approximately 0945 hours, Security was standing in the Galleria observing a student pushing a cart. The cart was stopped by the transition strip between the tile floor and the carpeted area. When the cart stopped abruptly, the glass jar slid off the cart onto the tiled floor. The jar shattered and the liquid contents spilled onto the floor. Subsequent investigation revealed that the individual pushing the cart was a lab aide. She was transporting the chemicals (organic waste) from ST 106 to ST 221 where it was to be properly disposed. Plant Operations was dispatched to the scene and applied absorbent and decontaminated the area. There were no injuries. Long term damage to the tile is unknown at this time.
