Summary			
<p>On date and time stated above, security responded to the Administration area for report of suspected theft. A student was seen entering the president's area copy room and leaving with a ream of paper. When questioned by staff, he first said he was a part-time employee and was allowed to be in that area. Afterwards, a staff member recognized him as a former worker-study student who worked in the Development Office. She was his former supervisor but he was no longer employed by their office. When she questioned him, he then said he was told by another staff member to get the paper and bring it down to the vice-president's area. Another staff member noticed the discussion in the hallway and accompanied the other staff member during the confrontation. As the student was questioned, his story changed several times, plus it was noted that the staff member he mentioned could not have talked him since she had been out sick. Both staff members detained the student until Security arrived to take a report. It appears, but has not been, that the student took the ream of paper to another copier within the senior administration area so that he could make copies and may have fabricated his story to avoid getting into trouble. Throughout the investigation, it was discovered that the student was dismissed from his position in the Development Office and not rehired due to behavioral issues including returning to the senior administration area several times even when asked not to return. The student voluntarily opened his book bag and allowed security to review its contents to show that he had not stolen anything. The staff member confirmed that the student was a registered for classes for the 2007 semester. The student was told that he could leave to attend his classes but that an incident report would issued and forwarded to student services for follow-up. The matter was referred to the Associate Vice President of Student Development who has requested a meeting with the student to discuss his actions and see if he needs student assistance. She has also requested that the student not visit the senior administration area as well.</p>
