Required Documentation

1. Nomination letter from the community college president
(HCC students do not need to request; it will be included for student if nominated)
2. Scholarship Application
3. Personal Statement of the student's educational and career goals
4. Official copy of the community college transcript – we accept password-protected files, secured documents using electronic delivery such as Parchment, or Electronic Transcript sent to the USM Office (FICE code 007959).
(HCC students do not need to request; it will be included for student)
5. Unofficial copies or grade slips from all other colleges and universities attended
6. Résumé or listing of the student's extracurricular and community activities
7. Evidence of the student's scholarly and creative activities – limit of two items (can include scanned copies of artwork, photos, creative projects, research papers, published material, honors, awards, etc.)
8. One or two letters of recommendation from faculty or staff members at the community college
9. Please do not submit the application items in folders or binders - staples or clips are permitted.

Please note:

1. Preference will be given to Maryland residents during the scholarship selection process.
2. Students must submit the FAFSA in order to be considered for any of the Kelly Regents Scholarships or Grants.
3. **Items with the student's personal information should be sent by more secure means such as password-protected documents, fax, direct mailing or Electronic Transcript.**
4. Other documentation -- such as letters of nomination, scholarly/creative evidence, or recommendations -- may be sent by fax or by email with attachments.
