

Articulation Agreement

Southern New Hampshire University – College of Online and Continuing Education and

Howard Community College

I. PURPOSE

Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) and Howard Community College (HCC), in the spirit of academic cooperation, and in order to facilitate the transfer of graduates of Howard Community College to Southern New Hampshire University - College of Online and Continuing Education (SNHU-COCE), hereby do enter into an academic articulation "Agreement". Successful implementation of the Agreement is dependent upon communication of its content to all involved participants and the assumption of responsibility by both institutions for such communications.

II. TRANSFER PATHWAY(S)

- 1. As SNHU is regionally accredited, all academic course work in which a student has earned a grade of "C-" or higher is fully transferable based on the attached course equivalents. Up to 90 credits may be accepted in transfer toward a bachelor's degree program.
- 2. Based on the course equivalency tables attached (see Appendix 1), SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education guarantees transferability of all credits outlined in the following Howard Community College associate degrees to their corresponding SNHU-COCE bachelor's degrees:
 - AA Business Administration to BS Business Administration
 - AA General Studies-Liberal Arts to BA General Studies
 - AA Nursing to BS Nursing (RN-BSN)
- 3. Any students enrolling at SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education may transfer up to 90 credit hours for a bachelor's with unlimited CLEP, DANTES and Excelsior, military training (based upon a transcript from the American Council on Education (ACE), College Credit Recommendation Service or Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) transcript) and ACE or National College Credit Recommendation Service (NCCRS) credits providing students meet residency requirements. Transfer credit is awarded based on degree program requirements. Residency requirements equate to 30 credit hours or 10 classes.



III. TERMS

- 1. During the Term of this Agreement, each Howard Community College Alumni, Employees, Employee's Family members (spouses, domestic partners, children, siblings, and parents), and Retirees who identifies Partner on his or her COCE discount application will receive a 10% tuition discount. In addition, Howard Community College Alumni, Employees, Employee's Family members (spouses, domestic partners, children, siblings, and parents), and Retirees who enroll in the University's COCE graduate program will receive a waiver of the application fee normally required by the University. No application fee waiver, tuition credit, or refund shall be made retroactively for any Howard Community College Alumni, Employees, Employee's Family members (spouses, domestic partners, children, siblings and parents), and Retirees already enrolled at the University on the date of execution of this Agreement; however, the tuition discount shall be applied to such Alumni, Employees, Employee's Family members (spouses, domestic partners, children, siblings and parents), and Retirees for course enrollments following the execution of this Agreement.
- 2. SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education may change its tuition rates at any time at its sole discretion and the reduction will be calculated based on the current tuition in effect for the applicable academic term for the enrolled program. Eligible employees and alumni shall not be entitled to any other reduction and are subject to all other admission and continuation requirements as set forth in the respective Southern New Hampshire University policies and catalogs.
- 3. Southern New Hampshire University College of Online and Continuing Education agrees to provide Howard Community College, at their request, an annual update of student enrollment, to include general data on how many students have transferred to SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education.
- 4. The parties will comply with all provisions of the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act ("FERPA") in all disclosures of FERPA protected information between HCC and SNHU. For example, the parties may be able to share personally identifiable information from a student's record for purposes related to a student's enrollment or transfer, per 34 C.F.R §§ 99.31 (a)(2) and 99.34. Also consistent with FERPA, the parties shall use reasonable methods to ensure that they provide only those education records that are necessary to the purpose for the disclosure as permitted under FERPA. Nothing in this Agreement may be construed to allow the parties to maintain, use, disclose, or share student record information in a manner not allowed under applicable laws or regulations.
- 5. This Agreement is effective as of the date of the fully executed document and shall continue until terminated. Both parties must approve amendments to the Agreement in



writing. Either party may terminate the Agreement without cause upon 90 days written notice to the other party. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate the Agreement immediately in the event that participation under the Agreement may give rise to a violation of any requirement of federal or state law or regulation or the requirements of any accrediting agency having jurisdiction.

- 6. Admission criteria, academic requirements, and other admission requirements will be subject to the applicable academic catalog accessed through snhu.edu at the time of the students' admission. Students who have begun their SNHU program of study or students in the process of enrolling prior to the effective date of any without cause termination will be grandfathered in to continue receiving the discount offered in this Agreement until such time such students complete or discontinue enrollment in their program.
- 7. Transferability of third- party course work will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- 8. This Articulation Agreement is based on the current curriculum of both educational institutions. Each institution is responsible for notifying the other of any substantive changes to the curriculum. Both institutions annually shall review this agreement.
- 9. The parties grant to each other a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use each other's trademarks and service marks in furtherance of the articulation coordination detailed herein or in a manner solely for the purpose of identifying and communicating the existence of the relationship to Howard Community College's students and alumni. Use of trademarks, service marks and logos will comply with use policies of the originating institution. The parties shall discontinue the use of the licensed marks and return all files and materials containing the licensed marks supplied by the owner at termination or expiration of the Agreement. Neither party grants to the other any interest in the other party's trademarks. Should either originating institution request, in writing, that a particular use of the originating institution's trademarks and/or service marks be discontinued, the non-originating institution shall cease and desist such use of the trademarks and/or service marks.
- 10. Howard Community College agrees to notify students of transfer opportunities to SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education, to collaborate with SNHU College of Online and Continuing Education on other forms of transfer communication and to host SNHU representatives on campus for recruitment activities during the academic school year.
- 11. "Reverse Transfer" allows students to transfer course work from SNHU back to HCC to complete requirements for the associate degree. This program is specifically designed to allow students to receive the advantages pursuant to completion of the associate degree when they leave HCC prior to degree completion. SNHU and HCC will work to develop a reverse transfer process to provide students with the opportunity to complete the associate degree while working on their SNHU bachelor's degree. Student records will be



exchanged between SNHU and the colleges of HCC for this purpose, strictly adhering to all privacy regulations and ensuring compliance with FERPA. Criteria for reporting will be determined by both institutions when the reverse transfer process is launched. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Parties are not obligated to enter into any reverse transfer agreement in the absence of a signed, written agreement detailing these obligations.

- 12. The parties hereto will have the relationship of independent contractors for all purposes. Each will have complete control over its own performance and the details for accomplishing its own obligations under this Agreement. In no event will the agents, representatives or employees of one party be deemed agents, representatives or employees of the other.
- 13. This Agreement may be executed by a duly authorized representative of each party, either by electronic or facsimile transmission, each of which will be considered an original.

All notices and other communications required hereunder by either party to the other shall be in writing, delivered personally, by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, or by overnight courier, and shall be deemed to have been duly given when delivered personally or received when using overnight courier or three business days after being deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

Transfer Credit Policy

Transfer equivalents earned prior or subsequent to this academic year will be evaluated on a case by case basis for transfer equivalency.
- RN to BSN Admission Requirements:
 - o Hold an earned diploma or associate degree in nursing from an accredited nursing program (ACEN, CCNE, and CNEA) OR state Board of Nursing approved program that prepares students for the NCLEX-RN exam
 - o Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 on the degree awarding transcript OR a cumulative GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 on the degree awarding transcript with a minimum of nine (9) credit hours earned subsequent to the diploma or associate degree with at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
 - o Students who do not hold a nursing license and have graduated from a nursing program within three months may be admitted if they meet all other admission requirements. Evidence of licensure must be provided within three months from date of admission.
 - o If you are an RN to BSN student interested in the Accelerated RN to MSN, contact an SNHU admission counselor or your SNHU academic advisor for more information as admission into the RN to MSN program is contingent upon a 3.5 GPA and dean approval.
- Nursing students are required to maintain a B- or better in core major courses.
- Students may transfer up to 90 credits if previous credits earned meet SNHU Online degree requirements and academic standards for transfer.
- Students must take at least 30 credits (10 classes) at SNHU Online to be awarded a bachelor's degree.
