Howard Community College (hereafter referred to as HCC), a community college in Howard County, Maryland and Washington Adventist University (hereafter referred to as WAU), an institution in Montgomery County, Maryland agree to offer an articulated program leading to the awarding of an Associate of Arts in Music degree and a Bachelor of Arts in Music degree or a Bachelor of Music in Music Performance degree or a Bachelor of Music in Music Education degree. HCC course agreements outlined below ensure that the transfer student will matriculate with junior standing.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement (the "Agreement") is to establish collaboration between Washington Adventist University (WAU) and Howard Community College (HCC) to facilitate the transfer and degree completion of students earning the Associate of Arts in Music at HCC to the Bachelor of Arts in Music or the Bachelor of Music in Music Performance or the Bachelor of Music in Music Education at WAU. This agreement provides a systematic plan for students to continue their higher education beyond their Associate's Degree from HCC. The following general principles guide the operation of this Agreement:

II. ADMISSIONS

Applicants successfully completing the articulated program with a 2.5 or better grade point average who have not matriculated at any other institution of higher education will be guaranteed transfer admission to WAU. Students must receive a grade of C or better for transfer of individual courses.

III. ACCEPTANCE OR CREDIT

Upon the completion of Associate of Arts degree in Music from HCC, a maximum of 90 credit hours from HCC will be allowed toward fulfillment of the 120 or 128 or 138 (dependent upon the degree sought) credit hours required for baccalaureate completion.

A. General Education Credits:

All courses meeting general education requirements at HCC will transfer to WAU to satisfy lower-level general education requirements where appropriate. Successful students must complete additional general education requirements for a Bachelor's degree at WAU.

B. Credits Accepted from Other Institutions:

If courses are evaluated by HCC and applied toward the Associate's Degree, the student must submit the score report to be evaluated by WAU. Credit will be applied as determined by a WAU evaluation. Grades at the C-level and below are not transferable to WAU.

C. Non-Direct Classroom Credit:

The maximum number of credits that will be accepted by WAU toward requirements from non-direct classroom instruction (including CLEP, Co-op Education, AP, and other nationally recognized standardized examination scores) is 24. The policy on the transferring in of non-direct classroom credit can be found in the Academic Information section of the WAU current bulletin.

D. Reverse Transfer of Credit:

WAU will assist with HCC degree completion agenda by identifying students who have transferred to WAU without completing the A. A. degree in Music but have completed 45 or more credits from HCC, and by sharing student's WAU transcript with HCC.

IV. SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

HCC students who have completed an Associate's Degree will be given every consideration for financial assistance and will be eligible to compete for need and non-need based academic scholarships including:

Dean's Scholarship awards \$3,000 annually for transfer students with a 3.2 and above GPA Founder's Scholarship awards \$1,500 annually for transfer students with a 2.75-3.19 GPA

V. BENEFITS TO STUDENTS

WAU offers the following benefits for HCC students who transfer under this Agreement:

Application fee waiver
Transfer advising services
Transfer orientation
Guaranteed Admission with a completed Associates in Music Degree and a 2.5 minimum GPA

VI. PROMOTION/OUTREACH

HCC and WAU agree to publicize the Agreement via, but not limited to, marketing materials and information sessions. WAU's transfer pathway will be featured on HCC's agreement and transfer website. HCC and WAU agree to collaborate to ensure successful transfer day visits, and information sessions.

VII. TERM/MONITOR/REVIEW

- A. The initial term of this agreement shall be two years from the date of the last signature, with three (3) automatic renewals of two years each.
- B. HCC and WAU further agree to monitor the performance of this Agreement and to review biennially.
- C. WAU will establish a mechanism to provide information on the academic progress of the HCC student enrollment as a result of this Agreement, including but not limited to statistical data compiled from non-specific student information.
- D. HCC and WAU agree to communicate program changes within the academic year of the change to avoid disruption of student progress toward degree completion.

VIII. TERMINATION

The Agreement may be terminated by either party for due cause and after 60 days of notice in writing to all parties. Termination of the Agreement will not affect any student currently enrolled at HCC in the name or major at the time of termination, and they shall be able to transfer credits pursuant to this Agreement.
