Subject to the terms of this agreement, a student who satisfactorily completes the requirements of the Associate in Applied Science Degree in the programs specified in the attached articulation of courses will be granted junior status in the School of Hospitality Management at Widener University.

The following terms and conditions shall apply:

- 1. The student must achieve a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- 2. The student must meet deadline dates for application, payment of fees, etc., that Would normally apply to other new students at Widener.
- The student shall choose the recommended elective courses and course sequences at Howard Community College as agreed to on the attached course equivalence sheet.

If any of the above terms and conditions are not met, Widener University shall determine appropriate transfer of credit on an individual basis.

Students who wish to transfer to Widener University prior to qualifying for the Associate of Applied Science Degree at Howard Community College must submit their transcript for evaluation on a course-to-course basis by Widener University.

Either Widener University or Howard Community College may terminate the agreement at any time by written notice thirty days in advance of the effective date of termination. It is understood that any termination will not apply to students who have already started the Associate Degree Program in Hospitality Management at Howard Community College or the Bachelor Degree Program at Widener University.
