

Minimum Academic Standards for Students on an Approved Academic Plan

Students on Financial Aid SAP Restriction, who submit an appeal and receive appeal approval, are placed on an "Academic Plan," developed in a meeting with an academic advisor.

While on an approved Academic Plan, you are eligible for financial aid, and you will continue to be eligible for financial aid, as long as you meet the standards for students on an Academic Plan, right.

The purpose of an Academic Plan is to allow you the time to get the support you need to improve your academic performance in order to bring yourself into compliance with the minimum SAP standards and eventually graduate from your program. Students on an Academic Plan Must Meet the Following Standards Every Term:

Semester GPA	
<i>If I'm not meeting the cumulative GPA requirements then:</i>	
0-15 credits attempted	semester GPA: 2.5
16-30 credits attempted	semester GPA: 2.5
31-40 credits attempted	semester GPA: 2.5
41 or more credits attempted	semester GPA: 3.0
Semester Pace/Completion Requirements	
<i>If I'm not meeting the cumulative Pace requirements then:</i>	
0-30 credits attempted	Complete 57% of credits attempted for the term
31-40 credits attempted	Complete 57% of credits attempted for the term
41 or more credits attempted	Complete 67% of credits attempted for the term
Maximum Timeframe Exceeded	
<i>If I've exceeded the Maximum 150% timeframe to complete, then:</i>	
Every term	Complete 67% of credits attempted for the term

Students on an Academic Plan will be placed back into "good standing" once they meet the minimum Financial Aid **Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Standards** as described in the policy on our website and summarized in the chart, right.

0-15 credits attempted	cumulative GPA: 1.0
16-30 credits attempted	cumulative GPA: 1.5
31-40 credits attempted	cumulative GPA: 1.75
41 or more credits attempted	cumulative GPA: 2.0
Cumulative Pace/Completion Requirements	
0-30 credits attempted	Complete 50% of credits attempted
31-40 credits attempted	Complete 57% of credits attempted
41 or more credits attempted	Complete 67% of credits attempted
Maximum Timeframe To Complete	
For current active program	150% of program length in credits
